

General Event Regulations / Rules of Participation

**Workshop titled “Viewing Space Through Machine Learning and Astrostatistics (VISTULA),”
September 21–25, 2026.**

Organizer: **National Centre for Nuclear Research (NCBJ)**

1. General Provisions

1. These regulations set forth the rules for participation in the VISTULA workshop organized by the National Centre for Nuclear Research (NCBJ), hereinafter referred to as the “Organizer.”
2. Participation in the workshop requires registration and payment of the conference fee in accordance with the rules set forth by the Organizer.
3. Registration constitutes acceptance of these rules and regulations.

2. Registration and Payments

1. Registration is conducted via the form provided by the Organizer.
2. The conference fee is paid by bank transfer or online payment.
3. Refunds may only be issued to the account from which the payment was made, in accordance with the NCBJ’s financial security policies.

3. Refund Policy

1. The Organizer allows for the refund of the conference fee upon receipt of a written request from the participant, sent to the Organizer’s email address: pawel.bielewicz@ncbj.gov.pl. The Organizer notes that a portion of the event’s costs is incurred in advance, which affects the possibility and scope of refunds.
2. Refunds of the conference fee are available until September 1, 2026. In particularly justified cases, at the Organizer’s discretion, a refund may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
3. After the above deadline, the conference fee is non-refundable, regardless of the reason for cancellation.

4. Changes to Registration

1. A participant may change their registration information (e.g., change the person delegated by the participant) after contacting the Organizer in advance.
2. Changing the person delegated by the participant does not affect the conference fee.
3. The Organizer may refuse to approve changes if they are submitted too late, i.e., after the participant lists have been prepared for service providers.

5. Participants’ Responsibilities

1. Participants are required to comply with the safety rules in effect on the NCBJ premises.
2. On the NCBJ premises, participants are required to present identification, and photography is prohibited unless the Organizer decides otherwise.
3. Participants are required to respect the NCBJ infrastructure and follow the instructions of technical staff.

6. Organizer's Liability

1. The Organizer is responsible for the conduct of the event, the program content, communication with participants, and financial settlements.
2. The Organizer is not liable for:
 - items left unattended,
 - events resulting from force majeure,
 - administrative decisions beyond the Organizer's control (e.g., admission restrictions, changes to safety regulations).
3. The Organizer reserves the right to change the program, schedule, or location of individual sessions.

7. Processing of Personal Data

1. The Organizer is the controller of participants' personal data.
2. Data is processed solely for the purpose of organizing the event, in accordance with applicable law.
3. Detailed information regarding data processing can be found in the privacy notice available with the registration form.

8. Final Provisions

1. In matters not covered by these rules, decisions shall be made by the Organizer.
2. These rules may be updated, and the current version will be published on the event website.
